**President:** The President shall be the chief executive officer of the Association and shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Association subject to the direction of the Officers and Directors. The President shall appoint all committees of the Association subject to the approval of the Officers and Directors. The President shall submit to the members annually at their meeting a report of the status of the Association and its activities during the preceding year. The term of office is one year.

**First Vice-president:** Shall in the absence, disability or inability to act as the President, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President and shall perform such other duties as the President shall from time to time prescribe.

**Second Vice-president:** Shall in the absence, disability or inability to act as the President or First Vice-president, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President and shall perform such other duties as the President shall from time to time prescribe.

**Secretary:** The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and of the officers and directors and shall record or cause to be recorded all notes taken and the minutes of all proceedings in a minute book of the Association to be kept for that purpose. He shall perform the duties for the committees when requested to do so.

**Treasurer:** The Treasurer shall have responsibility of preparing a budget; report to all meetings the Association's expenditures in relation to the budget and work under the guidance of the Youth Advisor and the Treasurer of the Indiana Quarter Horse Association.

**Reporter:** Shall have the responsibility of reporting on the activities of the Association and of the individual members of the Association to the Indiana Quarter Horse Journal. The Reporter shall serve as Historian of the Association and shall have and perform such other duties, authorities and responsibilities as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors or the President.

**Directors:** Shall exercise equal voting privileges with the Officers in managing the business and property of the IQHYA. If an office holder misses two or more meetings in succession or a total of three, the matter will go before the Youth Board and Advisors for consideration of dismissal.

To Improve and develop the capabilities of youth, both individually and through group participation, in the breeding, raising and exhibition of American Quarter Horses. To develop and improve scholarship, leadership and clean living among all its members. To encourage high moral character, sportsmanship.
